Cats must arrive in covered humane traps.

Set trap night before clinic only
and do no open trap or attempt to
remove cat from trap.

Bring a clean, small, plastic carrier
(airline type) for recovery, lined with towel.

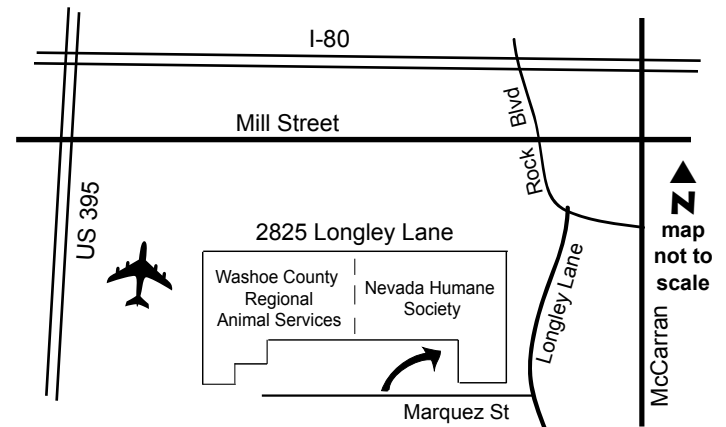
**TRAP SHOULD STAY COVERED

PICK-UP Sundays 3 pm / Wednesdays 4 pm Same Day

- A \$10 donation per cat is requested at time of drop-off - vouchers are available.
- Coverings should not be of sentimental or monetary value.
- Schedule and location subject to change - check the website or call for any changes.
- Limit of two cats per day.
- Kittens must be minimum 2 lbs in weight.

Post surgery care

- Cats are to stay in their covered carriers overnight in a safe, warm and quiet environment.
- Do not open carrier - no food or water until cat is released.
- Gently release cats in the area they were trapped, away from traffic.
